

House Henry Dunant, Puits-Saint-Pierre 4 in Geneva

Aims and activities

Created in 1975, the Henry Dunant Society gathers people willing to encourage the search and distribution concerning the life, work, thoughts and contribution of the founders of Red Cross: Henry Dunant, Guillaume Henri Dufour, Gustave Moynier, Louis Appia and Théodore Maunoir. Its field of activity also extends to the people who set the foundations of this vocation like Jean-Jacques de Sellon, or who assured its development like Edouard Castres or Gustave Ador.

- **Encourage** the studies on the life and the work of the founders of Red Cross and those who contributed to the humanitarian vocation of Geneva
- **Edit** a *Bulletin*, the *Henry Dunant Collection*, the *Documents to be of use to the history of the Red Cross and Red Crescent*
- **Emphasize** remembrances and up lead historic colloquiums
- **Organize** study tours: Solferino, Heiden, Nîmes, Tunisia, Alger, Sétif, Djémila, Luzern, Heidelberg, Bern, Dijon, Bordeaux, Hanau, St Gallen, Strasbourg, Macedonia, Kosovo, Frankfurt, Qingdao, Beijing, Torre Pelice
- **Promote** places dedicated to the founders, Install busts in their effigy, place commemorative tablets
- **Maintain links** with:
 - the Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies
 - The Henry Dunant Association
 - The YMCA's
- **Collaborate** with the corresponding members active in 15 countries
- **Make sensitive** the public opinion, the decision-makers, the media, the teachers and the youth.




Center of historical searches on the humanitarian vocation of Geneva


